One-page summary for capture leads and directors of federal sales. Themes distilled from GMU Baroni Center on-demand panels (2025–2026) and mapped to the FedShredder Pilot Sprint.

1. Revolutionary FAR Overhaul (RFO)

What buyers hear: Agencies want less prescriptive compliance theater and more delivery; industry should move away from 100-page statements of work and long eval cycles (OFPP/GSA panel, April 2026).

Operator risk: Teams thin the narrative but delete the traceability shell. A protest or CO question exposes missing Section L/M mapping.

FedShredder answer: Source-cited Section L/M baseline with citation QA on every row. Delivery story can shrink; defensibility does not.

2. AI in proposal evaluations

What buyers hear: When agencies use AI to score proposals, losers may protest over insufficient human in the loop (Baroni panel, May 2026).

Operator risk: Generic AI tools produce citations that do not survive PDF spot-check.

FedShredder answer: Human-reviewed compliance acceleration. Download the public matrix, spot-check rows against the PDF, then talk to us.

3. Consolidation and reform stack

What buyers hear: GSA OneGov, DOGE-related efficiency pushes, and defense acquisition reform change how solicitations arrive—not whether traceability matters.

Operator risk: B&P burn on pursuits that fail Step 1 alignment; spreadsheet rebuilt from scratch on every amendment.

FedShredder answer: 24-hour scoped Pilot Sprint; amendment-delta refresh on retainer. Go/no-go flags before pink team.
